Modicare Foundation (MCF) was set up in 1996. The Foundation has a long history of reaching out to the most vulnerable communities. We directly empower children, adolescents, women and the underprivileged using a comprehensive approach of education, health, nutrition, life skills and leadership building. A multi-disciplinary, highly skilled and trained team ensures effective implementation of our vision. We work in partnership with government, NGOs and industry.

Mission

Projects

 - i) Khwabgah Jasola The Foundation has adopted two SDMC schools in Jasola, SDMC Pratibha Vidyalaya Jasola Girls and SDMC Pratibha Vidyalaya Jasola Boys and is working towards the overall development of the students.
 - **ii) Khwabgah Noor Nagar** Modicare Foundation has adopted two more schools in Noor Nagar SDMC Primary School Noor Nagar Girls and SDMC Primary School Noor Nagar Boys for the overall development of the students.
- **3) Partners in Change -** training and awareness building is provided to organizations on critical social issues.
- **4) Hifazat** a comprehensive community healthcare initiative that is working with the students of Khwabgah and the larger community
- **5) Roopantar** infrastructure improvement project for government schools

OVERVIEW

Modicare Foundation is pleased to present the work done in 2021-22. Despite the repeated lockdowns and uncertainties surrounding the school reopening, the Foundation is proud of the work done during the pandemic.

Modicare Foundation had adopted two schools in Jasola under the **Khwabgah** project – SDMC Pratibha Vidyalaya Girls and SDMC Pratibha Vidyalaya Boys in 2016. Due to the interventions made by the Foundation, the learning levels and enrolment numbers of the schools had improved considerably. During the lockdowns and school closures, the Foundation took to online teaching, distribution of workbooks, developing and disseminating educational videos to help continue the children's education. Due to the transformational work done by the Foundation, SDMC wanted the Foundation to adopt more schools to replicate the success of the schools in Jasola. Therefore, at the behest of SDMC, two more schools were adopted – SDMC Primary School Noor Nagar Boys and SDMC Primary School Noor Nagar Girls. The school's infrastructure is being overhauled, apart from which the Foundation will be providing state of the art furniture and academic facilitators for the overall development of the students.

The paucity of classrooms in the two schools in Jasola because of the high enrolment numbers provided an opportunity for Modicare Foundation to launch a new project called – **Roopantar.** Under this project, the Foundation will provide infrastructure improvements for government schools. The KK Modi Khwabgah Block with eight classrooms is being built in SDMC Jasola. It will address the problem of scarcity of classrooms and commemorate 25 years of public service of Modicare Foundation. The school block will be donated to SDMC and will be an environment friendly, sustainable and learning friendly building, which will benefit the students of SDMC Jasola and the community. Apart from the new school block, the Foundation will also be building a new toilet block and playground for the students of Jasola.




The coronavirus pandemic has brought healthcare to the forefront. To address the issues surrounding the lack of primary and preventive health services, Modicare Foundation launched a comprehensive health and hygiene initiative called **Hifazat**, which will focus on preventive healthcare and promotion of health and hygiene seeking behaviour. Under this project, an online webinar on dental hygiene was organised with a dentist. A health mela was organised for the students of the two Jasola schools and their mothers as the health of women and children are most often neglected in Indian households.

The Ambassadors of Change (AOC) project continued to reinvent itself and developed a full online life skills training module and videos, which was disseminated through the new YouTube channel. This helped the Foundation reach a larger audience even though the mobility was restricted. The AOC team conducted both online and offline trainings and utilized the resources to the maximum to effectively run this hybrid model. Last year the AOC team collaborated with the Government of Delhi to train Anganwadi workers. Trainings were also provided to organisations and corporates on POSH and other social issues.



PROJECT - AMBASSADORS OF CHANGE (AOC)



AIMS

- ❖ To enable adolescents to understand and accept their physical, emotional and mental changes associated with this phase of life.
- ❖ To enable primary school children to lead a safe, healthy and hygienic childhood.
- ❖ To equip adolescents with the skills that enables them to make informed choices for responsible behaviour.
- ❖ To create awareness on social issues in the community through partnerships with institutions.
- ❖ To build capacities of institutions to help them integrate life skills in their day-to-day activities with young adults and children.
- ❖ To ensure sustainable impact of the program.



1) ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2021-22

a) Content Development and Information Education Communication (IEC) Material Development

- ⇒ A comprehensive, unique and user-friendly FAQs booklet has been developed which is going to be disseminated to trained and other adolescents through digital media.
- ⇒ Development of leaflets on Covid awareness in Hindi and English language and dissemination to NGO representatives and adolescents through digital media platforms. These leaflets provided accurate information related to identification, prevention and precautions needed to safeguard oneself from the ongoing pandemic.



⇒ Updating the primary module in Hindi and English. This involved reviewing and editing the module and adding a session on puberty as the onset of periods are starting early.





- ⇒ **Creation of 45 training videos for** online dissemination. The life skills training videos include an introduction, life skills, growing up, peer pressure and bullying, responsible behaviour, substance abuse, HIV/AIDS and child sexual abuse.
- ⇒ **Thirty-one life skills training videos in English** were scripted and developed for dissemination via the Foundation's YouTube channel.

b) Training

- □ Collaboration with organizations to conduct Life Skills training with primary school going children and adolescents.
- □ Online and physical Life Skills training were conducted with primary children and adolescents in partnership with **25 organizations**. **2184 adolescents** and **630 primary school going children** were trained this year.
- ☐ Under the Ambassadors of Change project, **85 online and physical trainings** were successfully conducted



☐ First online Training of Trainers (TOT) conducted successfully with 907

Anganwadi workers and supervisors of ICDS in collaboration with the

Department of Women and Child Development, Government of Delhi.



c) Coverage through Digital Media

- Launch of Modicare Foundation's YouTube channel to increase the reach of the Life Skills trainings. Since the reach to children and adolescents was curtailed by the pandemic, the Foundation launched its YouTube channel to widen the coverage and reach the unreached. Till now the YouTube channel has garnered 1282 subscribers, viewership of 35,500 and 3,45,500 impressions.
- Various tools of social media were also explored to maximize coverage, like creation of reels (short videos) on Instagram with crisp and relevant content to increase the audience traffic on our YouTube channel. Ten Instagram reels were created for the promotion of the YouTube channel. The Instagram page has 934 followers and total views on the posted reels are 6,598.

d) Reporting and Documentation

- Conducting weekly meetings to review the progress of the work done. Daily
 morning and evening meetings were held during the lockdowns to monitor the
 tasks and assignments.
- Monthly and quarterly reports as well as training reports were prepared regularly and submitted to the coordinators and organizations respectively.

e) Capacity Building

- AOC team members' capacity was enhanced with respect to online training content and uniformity in delivering key messages in a crisp manner through mock sessions.
- Various new tools were learnt to promote the Foundation's online presence like making Instagram reels and videos.
- o Two trainings were conducted for the team laws related to women and POSH.

2) CHALLENGES FACED BY AOC

a) Planning and Implementation

- In financial year 2021-22, India witnessed two lockdowns because of the coronavirus pandemic, which hampered the implementation of the plan considerably. The same affected all the partner organizations as well, which further made it difficult to complete the planned activities.
- Schools continued to remain closed for primary school going children and although towards the end of the year, they gradually opened, life skills training was not a priority for the school authorities, as they had to concentrate on the curriculum.
- High levels of pollution was another major hindrance to planning and many scheduled trainings had to be cancelled as the organizations could not call children to their centres.

b) Training

- Several scheduled online and physical trainings were cancelled because of the recurring Covid waves, pollution and subsequent closure of schools and organizations.
- The organizations also faced challenges with respect to technology and resources like internet connectivity and well ventilated spaces for conducting the training.



Class Performance based on February 2022 Assessment

After re-opening of the school in February, assessments were prepared for all the three main subjects – Hindi, Maths and English - for students of Class 2-5 to determine the learning level of the students. It would help in segregation of the students based on their learning level and planning remedial classes for the students.

Class averages are low due to the closure of the schools for two years due to the pandemic. Our students are underprivileged learners with limited access to smart devices and having internet connectivity issues. Most of the parents are unable to recharge their phones on time for online learning.

Partners in Change is an initiative of the Foundation towards learning and collaboration. Under this program, training and awareness building is provided to organizations on critical social issues. The Foundation provides technical support to corporate/industries, institutions, and NGOs to develop a comprehensive program on HIV/AIDS, Reproductive Health, Gender and Prevention of Sexual Harassment at Workplaces (POSH) within their workplace.

Modicare Foundation has been an authorized POSH training partner for the Ministry of Women and Child Development. The Foundation is a special invitee for the Internal Committee (in house grievance redressal committees) meetings of many corporates and establishments.

ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN IN 2021-22

- 8 Internal Committee meetings and 22 POSH trainings were conducted with Bussan Auto Finance, Global Dent Aids, Adecco India, Modicare, Modicare Foundation, National Herald, Department of Women and Child Development, Government of Delhi (ICDS)
- Two workshops on HIV/AIDS was conducted with Global Dent Aids Pvt. Ltd.
- Training was conducted with 1435 employees and staff members of corporates and companies. The training topics include POSH, HIV/AIDS, POCSO Act, Substance Abuse and Gender Sensitization. This included 907 Anganwadi workers and supervisors.





PROJECT - HIFAZAT



Hifazat is a comprehensive health program initiated in 2020. The primary objective of Hifazat is to bring about improvement in the health of women and children. It provides health services to the underprivileged community. Along with this, it also focusses on spreading awareness on issues of health and hygiene and encourages the community to adopt and follow appropriate behaviour for better health.

OBJECTIVES

- To bring improvement in the health of women and children and to provide health services to the underpriveleged community.
- To generate awareness on healthcare within the community.
- To encourage the community to adopt and follow health-approriate behaviour

ACTIVITIES UNDER HIFAZAT

 Need assessment done with 200 community women and men via four focus group discussions.



- Awareness videos developed and uploaded on our YouTube channel on Covid, eye
 care, oral/ dental hygiene, and reproductive and menstrual health. The total
 viewership is over 2000.
- Attractive health card and user friendly IEC Materials developed.
- Conducted a webinar on Omicron, a variant of Covid, and oral hygiene with 300 parents.
- Conducted the first health mela which benefitted over 250 women and children.
 The height and weight of the students was measured to map the growth levels of the children. A thorough eye and dental check up was also done for the children. A gynaecologist was also present to check the mothers.
- Health kit was distributed to 106 families. It includes a digital thermometer, essential medicines, masks etc.


• Due to the interventions provided by Modicare Foundation in SDMC Pratibha Vidyalaya Jasola Girls School and SDMC Pratibha Vidyalaya Boys School, the enrolment has increased remarkably, because of which the students cannot be accommodated in the existing classrooms. To address this problem and commemorate 25 years of public service, the Foundation is donating an environment friendly, sustainable and learning friendly building to the students of Jasola and the community using structural steel (reduces the environmental footprint), terrazzo tiles (durable and long lasting), double walls (to reduce the



- dependence on electricity for cooling) and a vault roof (for protection from heat and cold). This is a first for NGO-Government relationship.
- The Foundation Stone for a new school block 'KK Modi Khwabgah Block' at SDMC Jasola was laid by Mr Samir Modi, Vice Chairperson Modicare Foundation; Mr Pardeep Kumar, Director Education SDMC and Ms Neetu Manish Chaudhary, Chairperson Health Committee SDMC on March 7, 2022.
